U12A – Each team play each other 3 x 9 teams = 24 games

With the possibility of a regional wrap up event, that will determine the regional champions, which will be held sometime at the end of March.

Give a minimum of 14 – 16 ice time slots to the ice scheduler.

Schedule to start in October 2 – March 23

U14A – Each team plays each other 3 times x 6 teams = 18 games

Plus play off format of – based on standings 1 vs 4, 2 vs 3

Schedule to start in October 2 – February 26

U16A - Each team play each other 4 times x 4 teams = 16 games

Plus play off format of – based on standings 1 vs 4, 2 vs 3

Schedule to start in October 2 – February 26

U19A – Each team play each other 2 times x 8 teams = 16 games

If the teams get dropped down to x 7 teams (losing Guelph from this division), home and away format = 14 games in total

Plus play off format of – based on standings 1 vs 4, 2 vs 3

Schedule to start in October 2 – February 26

Open A/U19AA – Each team plays each other 2 times x 5 teams = 10 games

Plus play off format of – based on standings 1 vs 4, 2 vs 3
